TREASURER'S REPORT

The available balances in our bank accounts at the end of July were;

Westpac \$2,829

CBA \$2,813

All refunds for functions cancelled as a result of Covid-19 have now been paid to members

During the month many payments that would normally be paid from the CBA function account were paid from the Westpac account using our new online payment capability. As a result, the Committee have agreed to my proposal that we transfer all CBA funds to Westpac and operate from a single bank account in future. Those members who are signatories on the CBA account will become signatories on the Westpac account and have full online access. Consolidation of the accounts will make it less confusing for members once we recommence functions post Covid-19, as they will be dealing with a single bank account. Furthermore, it will make EFTPOS easier to implement if we decide to go down that path.
